


ROSEBERY

FACT SHEET




Rosebery is an underground polymetallic base metal mine located on the west coast of Tasmania, Australia. The mine has operated continually since 1936 and is positioned in the centre of the township of Rosebery. The majority of Rosebery employees are local to the area, making the mine an integral part of the community.

The mine produces zinc, lead and copper concentrate and gold doré using mechanised underground mining methods and crushing, grinding and flotation processes.

Rosebery concentrates are transported by rail to the Port of Burnie where they are shipped in bulk carriers to smelters in Hobart and Port Pirie. Gold doré bars are sold to a refinery in Australia where they are refined into gold bullion.

Rosebery's production guidance for 2016 is 75,000–80,000 tonnes of zinc in zinc concentrate and 18,000–22,000 tonnes of lead in lead concentrate.

Traineeships and apprenticeships are available to local young people to provide entry level training programs and employment opportunities.
