WHAT IS A CADETSHIP?

The cadetship combines work and study across a structured four-year (full-time equivalent) program that provides hands-on learning, while completing a <u>Bachelor of Spatial</u> Science Technology (Surveying).

WHAT IS ON OFFER?

Successful cadets will receive on-site mentoring, roster flexibility to support work and study balance, the potential to receive up to 50% financial education assistance toward your degree and a competitive salary across the four-year program.

ELIGIBILITY

- Interest in surveying
- Completion of Year 12 or equivalent, with an ATAR score of 65.6 or higher
- Commitment to a four-year work and study program
- Work an 8 day on, 6 days off work roster at Dugald River mine

APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1 – apply and be accepted into program with USQ

- Recent Year 12 graduates to apply via QTAC or QTAC equivalent.
- Students aged 21 years or above to apply direct with University of Southern Queensland here.
