**Dugald River Mine**

**Resource activity: Mining activity relating to a mining lease**

It is advised that MMG Dugald River Pty Ltd has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority and a PRCP schedule in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The environmental authority and PRCP schedule being amended are EPML00731213 and P-PRCP-100846032.

The application relates to 4,335 ha of land, located off the Burke Developmental Road, within the Cloncurry Shire Council.

The resource activity is proposed to occur on the following tenure(s) and will involve: addition of three areas with associated mining lease applications (MLA100383, ML100382, ML100359), expansion of the Tailings Storage Facility, expansion of the Waste Storage Pad (PAF Pad 2), additional borrow pits, alternative groundwater contaminant limits, alternative air quality monitoring locations, and a reduction of the authorised maximum disturbance for certain features.
